


1. Create an account using a student's unique, personal email address.

 - Track A: TOEFL 71 - 79, or IELTS 6.0, or Duolingo 95 - 100
 - Track B: TOEFL 61 - 70, or IELTS 5.5, or Duolingo 85 - 90
 - Track C: TOEFL 49 - 60, or IELTS 5.0, or Duolingo 80
